CONFEDERATION OF CHIEFS OF UNITED TRIBES OF AOTEAROA

Order of decree: Nga uri o Tahinga (the descendants of Tahinga) do state unequivocally "Tahinga lands, forests, estates, resources and taonga are "SOVEREIGN" and held in 'Allodial Status" by sanguineous means by Nga uri o Tahinga.

Nga uri o Tahinga serve due notice that no assumed authority will be recognised over our

"SOVEREIGN LANDS". Any and all previous arrangements entered into by previous administrations are deemed to be "ultra vires" and "misfeasance".

A warning is served upon the N.Z. High Court that charges of "malfeasance" will be laid if our

'**MANA WAIRUA, MANA TIKANGA TUTURU, MANA WHENUA mea te MANA TANGATA**" are not acknowledged and respected.

The N.Z. High Courts attempts to alienate our properties by inciting whanau/hapu unrest to achieve its own self-serving ends is misbehavior and is duly recorded and noted within its own case records.

Further, notice of our intention to reoccupy "Nga uri o Tahinga" properties is hereby served.

Notices have been sent to current occupants and lease holders detailing our intended actions.

"Public Notice" has appeared warning past, present and future dealings with any but ourselves will not be recognized as valid.

We hereby claim sovereignty/kaitiakitanga over our properties, guaranteed by

- Aotearoa Sovereign Flag (1834)
- Declaration of Independence (1835)
- Te Tiriti O Waitangi (1840)
- N.Z. Constitution Act (s.71) (1852)
- Te mana o Nga uri o Tahinga (2003)

N.B. To disregard these institutions is to act in a treasonous and seditious manner against our sworn protector (King William IV) and our treaty partner Queen Elizabeth II.

Nga uri o Tahinga will not hesitate to support an "order to arms" if it be issued by HRM against you.

"GOD SAVE THE QUEEN."

Nga uri o Tahinga would also have it noted that we absolutely refute the right of the N.Z. High Court to deliver our properties (held in ALLODIAL STATUS) into the management of the Public Trust.

Nga uri o Tahinga regard this action as insulting in its paternalistic semi-veiled attempt to impose a blatant "land-grab" decision upon us.

Nga uri o Tahinga deny the legal authority of the N.Z. govt. and its various appointed and elected representatives on the grounds of our properties "allodial" status through consanguineous whakapapa.
